**Position:** Physiotherapist

### About the Role:

As a part of the interdisciplinary team and the lead clinician of the rehabilitation program, the Physiotherapist will provide assessment, develops rehabilitation or physical maintenance care plan, and conducts therapy to residents in Villa Cathay Care Home, a culturally focused, round-the-clock long-term care senior home.

The successful applicant will apply the evidence-based practice in the development and design of the rehabilitation programs. He or she will also lead and direct a rehabilitation team of 1 kinesiologist and 2 rehabilitation assistants, participate in care conference, and deliver ad hoc training and in-service. The physiotherapist will apply effective communication skills in working with the leadership, interdisciplinary care team, and care partners (including residents and families) to foster teamwork and the partnership in care. 5. Has Baccalaureate degree in Physical Therapy from an approved university program and has a current registration with the College of Physical Therapists of British Columbia.
